Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh, submits to the contrary, that the petitioners were actually not found residing at the place and it was found locked.

Be that as it may, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents no. 2 and 3 to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is duly protected, within the four corners of law.

If the petitioners find themselves under any threat, obviously they would be at liberty to take the course to legal proceedings.
