FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a second anticipatory bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C by the petitioner Pawan Kumar when earlier application of the petitioner as well as of his co-accused stood dismissed by this Court vide order dated 13.02.2017.

The allegations that need to be reproduced are that accused around 13 in number had consequent upon a criminal conspiracy through impersonation, forgery and fabrication created a power of attorney purported to have been executed by the complainant owner Sagar Malhotra of plot bearing No.1327, measuring 520 sq. yards and as a consequence of which sold the property.

The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that a civil suit of the petitioner has since been decreed and, thus, fresh

cause has arisen in favour of the petitioner is stoutly opposed by the learned State counsel on the grounds that petitioner is running a gang of land grabbers and that earlier vide detailed order of this Court the prayer of the petitioner has already been declined.

The sole contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that civil decree has been passed has already been considered by this Court in the previous order dated 13.02.2017 and as has been the conclusion drawn by this Court earlier no fresh ground is made out, canvassed or convincingly put forth by the learned counsel for the petitioner. Thus, finding no merit the present petition stands dismissed.
