INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners-Parminder Kaur alias Parminder and Harjinder Singh have filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 not to interfere in the peaceful married life of the petitioners at the instance of respondents No.4 to 12.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Mr. Ajaivir Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.4 and contested this petition.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 states that they have already moved a representation to the authorities for taking action against the petitioners.

In view of above, Without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the petitioners to contact respondents No.2 and 3 who, after their satisfaction

that the petitioners are actually facing threat, shall take necessary steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from private respondents No.4 to 12, as per law.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
