Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.33 dated 13th February, 2017 registered under Sections 323, 341, 354-B, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

The following order was passed by this Court on 28th of April, 2017 in this case :-

“It is submitted that the complainant was not in possession of the land in question. The said land had been leased out to petitioner No.1. Petitioners No. 1 and 4 had received injuries when the complainant and others attacked them. The police has not taken any action on their complaint.

Notice of motion for 4.7.2017.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Charanjit Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined investigation pursuant to the above said order. The custodial interrogation of the petitioners, it is submitted, is not required.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioners are likely to abscond or that they are likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 28th of April, 2017 is made absolute.
