Petitioner-Massa Singh has filed this 2nd petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail for 20 days to arrange and manage the marriage of his son-Gurpreet Singh and to perform the ceremonies during the marriage, during the pendency of trial in case FIR No.155 dated 18.09.2015, registered for the offence under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and filed reply which is taken on record.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

In reply filed on behalf of the respondent, it is admitted that marriage of son of the petitioner is to be solemnized on 27.01.2017 and a writing in this regard issued by the Panchayat has also been annexed with

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that presence of the petitioner is required in the marriage of his son which is to be solemnized on 27.01.2017, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted interim bail from 25.01.2017 to 29.01.2017, subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹1 lac with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner shall surrender before the Jail authorities on 30.01.2017 at 10.00 a.m. sharp.

The concerned Jail Superintendent is directed to send the report after the surrender of the petitioner-accused in the jail on 30.01.2017.

A copy of this order be given to learned counsel for the petitioner under signature of the Bench Secretary.
