RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(Oral)

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No. 17, dated 19.01.2017, under Sections 379-B/148/149/411/34 I.P.C., registered at Police Station Mattaur, District Mohali.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he was one of the occupants of the motorcycle, who snatched mobile of the complainant. He was identified by his Aadhar Card. Later on, names of the co-occupants of the motorcycle were known to be Kush Pahwa and Harjit Singh. The mobile was ultimately recovered from wife of the petitioner, namely Rashpal Kaur.

On verification of the facts, it has been found that co-accused Kush Pahwa and Harjit Singh have been granted bail by the trial Court. Rashpal Kaur and Balwinder Singh have also been granted bail by the trial Court.

The petitioner is in custody since 19.01.2017.

Learned State counsel on instructions from A.S.I. Surjit Singh submitted that challan has already been presented.

At this stage, without adverting to merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
