Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Hira Lal Chawla, Dinesh Chawla, Jatinder Chawla, Hatinder Chawla and Mohinder Paul Chawla in case registered by way of criminal complaint No.177/03.05.2016, SC-62/02.12.2016 titled 'State (through Drugs Control Officer, Rohtak v. Raj Kumar Sapra and others' under Sections 18/27 of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 in the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 28.04.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and have been released on bail and has placed on record copy of the orders of the trial

Court dated 03.05.2017 to this effect, which is not controverted by learned State counsel.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 28.04.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
