The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.220 dated 03.12.2016 registered under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 05.05.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner vehemently contended that the name of the petitioner has not been taken in the FIR and therefore, he has, prima facie, case for grant of anticipatory bail.

Upon hearing learned State counsel I find that during investigation which has surfaced that the petitioner in collusion with Baba Narinder Singh, a travel agent, have since took ₹10.9 lacs from the complainant and there is no intention to return back the amount.

In that view of the matter, I find that there is evidence against the petitioner, prima facie. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. NO.M-14594 OF 2017 is dismissed.
- (ii) Interim order dated 05.05.2017 is vacated.
