Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.76, dated 03.03.2016, registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323 and 307 of IPC, at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh.

Seeking regular bail for the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused Shubham who has been attributed an identical role as the petitioner, had earlier approached this Court through CRM-M-37638 of 2016-Shubham Vs. State of UT, Chandigarh and vide order of this Court dated 02.12.2016 he has been granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel has not controverted the above.

After considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and finding merit therein, I am of the considered opinion that the petitioner deserves to be admitted to regular bail.
