Pursuant to notice issued on 27.4.2017, Mr. Mehta, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Narjot Singh, submits that the statements of the petitioners have been recorded by the police of Police Station Sadar, Batala, to the effect that they are no longer under any threat from respondents no. 4 and 5.

Statements of the parents of petitioner no. 2 as well as of respondents no. 4 and 5 have also been recorded in the police station Sadar, Batala, to the effect that the lives and liberty of the petitioners would not be put to any danger.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, on the other hand, submits that as per his instructions, the petitioners have stated that respondents no. 4 and 5, who are the parents of petitioner no. 1, are still not agreeable to the marriage.

In the aforesaid situation, without making any comment on the validity of the marriage, this petition is disposed of with directions to respondents no. 2 and 3 to continue to ensure that the lives and liberty of petitioners is duly protected, within the four corners of law.

If any of the averments made in the petition are found to be false, legal proceedings initiated by a competent person would not be considered to be barred by virtue of this order.
