Through these two petitions under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.11 dated 11.01.2017 under Sections 323, 341, 148 and 149 I.P.C. (Sections 325, 324 and 326 added lateron) and D.D.R. No.23 dated 12.01.2017 under Section 323/34 IPC pertaining to Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda, on the basis of compromise.

On presentation of the petition, parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bathinda and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide his covering letter No.252 dated 07.06.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Bathinda vide Endst. No.806 dated 07.06.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bathinda, the compromise between the parties is genuine, voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.11 and DDR No.23, are hereby quashed.

Petitions are disposed of accordingly.
