INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Harcharan Singh has filed this 2nd petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.270 dated 22.12.2014, registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana, under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 24 of Immigration Act.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1-State and respondent No.2 also appeared through his counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that earlier petition filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 05.08.2016 and since then, neither the petitioner has surrendered before the police authorities, nor joined the investigation.

Keeping in view the facts that there are serious allegations against the present petitioner that he introduced agents to the complainant and money was paid at the house of the petitioner for sending the person to Canada etc. and visa was also found to be fake, this Court has already specifically held in the order dated 05.08.2016 that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

No ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
