The instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is directed against the order dated 04.09.2014 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana and in terms of which an application moved by the prosecution under Section 319 Cr.P.C. has been allowed and the present petitioner was summoned to face trial as an additional accused.

Counsel having argued the matter at some length prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to file a revision petition before the competent Court.

As per statement made by counsel, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
