

mentioned that daughter of the complainant was harassed for demand of dowry by Jasvir Singh husband of daughter of the complainant, mother-in-law Charanjit Kaur, Devar Harsharan Singh and Nanad Amandeep Kaur. It has been specifically mentioned in the FIR that on the date of occurrence at about 5.15 p.m. daughter of the complainant gave a call that her husband Jasvir Singh was beating her and she was very upset and at 8-00 p.m. Jasvir Singh gave a telephonic call to the complainant's wife that something happened to Harsimran Kaur. It is further submitted that husband and brother-in-law (Devar) have already been arrested and are in custody.”

It is submitted that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

It is, thus, prayed that this petition be allowed.

The factual position in regard to the marriage of the petitioner in the year 2011 is not denied.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Davinder Singh, verifies that the petitioner has joined investigation.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond or that she is likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 01.05.2017 is made absolute.
