Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Sulakhan Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 has been filed in Court today with copy thereof to learned counsel for the petitioner. The same is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

As per the said reply, the matter emanating from FIR No. 73 dated 30.05.2016 registered under Sections 363, 366(A), 34 IPC at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib has been thoroughly investigated. Three accused i.e. respondents No. 4 to 6 were proceeded against. They were arrested and have been granted the concession of bail. It is mentioned in the above said affidavit that investigation has been completed and the challan/final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. was presented on 11.01.2017. Charge against the accused person has been framed and the matter is now

fixed before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib for recording of prosecution evidence. The petitioner, in this case, has prayed for appropriate action to be taken in the above said FIR as it was averred that the police is not investigating the matter and is not taking any action thereon.

It is not denied that in view of the facts and circumstances as noted above, this petition has been rendered infructuous as the challan/final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been presented.

Disposed of accordingly.
