The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No. 122 dated 23.07.2015, under Section 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

As per the case of the petitioner she was arrested from her house and recovery of 105 strips of Aldix 0.5 each containing 10 tablets was planted on her on 10.05.2015. She was earlier granted interim bail but after receiving the report of Chemical Examiner she surrendered before the trial Court and since then she is in jail.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner makes a statement that after release from the jail the petitioner will file undertaking within two weeks from the date of her release that she would not indulge in any type of

offence and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned Police Station.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is ready to give an affidavit as stated above and is not required in any other similar case, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In that view of the matter I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-14790 of 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner shall file an affidavit within two weeks from the date of his releasing that he will not commit any other offence again.
