Petitioner-Surjit Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.85 dated 09.06.2014, registered at Police Station Phase VIII, Mohali, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 474 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, main allegations are against the wife of present petitioner. Earlier the petitioner was in

custody since 13.06.2014 and was granted interim bail by this Court vide order dated 30.05.2017.

Report of trial Court has been received mentioning the reasons as to why trial has not been concluded within one year, as asked by this Court. From the report, it is clear that case is not going to be decided in near future and it will take a long time.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without going into merits of the case, I find that that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in this petition, the same is allowed. Interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 30.05.2017 is made absolute.
