Petitioner claims that he is being threatened by respondent No.6, who is an ex.MLA belonging to Congress Party. Petitioner also claims that he belongs to Aakali Party. The prayer is for protection of life and liberty.

After going through the file, I am of the view that if respondent Nos.5 and 6 committed any crime, the petitioner is always at liberty to make a formal complaint to the police and if the police refused to investigate the matter, he can approach the higher authorities or Illaqa Magistrate with a complaint.

The petitioner is relegated to make the formal complaint before the police, if any crime is committed against him.
