KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The prayer of the petitioner in the present criminal petition is that that being 67 years of age, he should not be called to the Police Station time and again and humiliated. Further prayer has been made that his name be deleted from the Register No. 10 pertaining to the bad characters, maintained by the Police under Rule 23.4 of the Punjab Police Rules.

Reply of the State shows that the petitioner was earlier involved in several criminal cases but after 2001, the petitioner never involved in any case and after the enquiry, his name has been deleted from the said Register No. 10.

In view of the reply of the State which shows that since 2001, the petitioner has not indulged in any criminal or illegal activity, therefore, in the circumstances, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that the petitioner shall not to be called upon by the respondents except by way of issuing notice under Section 160 Cr. P.C. stating the reasons as to why his presence is required.
