I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The appellant was discharged from service on 21st June, 1984. The suit was brought on 7th March, 1988 beyond the period of limitation provided under the Limitation Act, 1963. The finding of the first appellate court is that the suit is barred by limitation. The finding is in consonance with the decision of the Supreme Court in State of Punjab and others vs. Gurdev Singh Ashok Kumar, AIR 1991 SC 2219. I find no perversity or illegality apparent on the face of record in the judgment and decree of the first appellate court.

In view of the above, this appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed.
