On 1.5.2017, following order was passed by this
Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was bailed out in the offence under Sections 399, 402, 411 IPC and under Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act. On 17.02.2017, petitioner absented himself from the Court due to typhoid for which he was treated in Government Hospital wherein widal positive was detected. He was advised five days rest and he could not inform his counsel. In the meanwhile, two of the co-accused have been acquitted by the trial Court on 28.04.2017.

Notice of motion for 23.05.2017.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on 08.05.2017 and in the event of his appearance, trial Court shall admit him on interim bail on furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds subject to its satisfaction.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and has been granted interim bail. This fact has not been disputed by learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh.

In view of aforesaid, interim order dated 1.5.2017 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
