Challan was submitted against the petitioner under Sections 15, 25, 61 and 85 of the NDPS Act. It is conceded on behalf of the State that the petitioner was originally on bail in the case. He, however, absented himself from the proceedings on account of which coercive process was issued against him and he was rearrested on 08.01.2017. Admittedly, the recovery from him was below the commercial quantity as prescribed in the Act.

In the given circumstances, the petitioner may be released on bail subject to imposition of such precautionary terms and conditions as deemed appropriate by the Ld. Trial Court.
