The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.139 dated 13.08.2016 under Sections 177/193/196/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the the petitioner stood surety on behalf of the accused who was released on probation. He further contends that in pursuance to the order dated 01.05.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has been granted *ad interim* bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jatinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 01.05.2017 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
