The petitioners approached this Court challenging the notifications Annexures P-1 and P-2 (dated 25.3.1994), Annexures P-3 and P-4 (dated 1.4.1994), Annexures P-5 to P-6 (23.3.1994), Annexures P-9 and P-10 (dated 17.2.1995), Annexures P-11 to P-14 (dated 24.2.1995), and Annexures P-15 and P-16 (dated 3.3.1995) acquiring land measuring 4.67 acres and 4.62 acres situated in the revenue District of Kapurthala, to develop pocket A and Pocket B, respectively, situated at Circular Road Kapurthala.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent no.2- Improvement Trust, Kapurthala, submitted that the Trust had dropped the scheme, hence, the present petition challenging the acquisition has been rendered infructuous.
