Vide order dated 01.05.2017, police was directed to verify the authenticity of certificate dated 12.12.2016 allegedly issued by Dr. Ajay Bansal, Bansal Orthopaedics and General Hospital, Jagraon to the petitioner. Petitioner has relied upon the said document to contend that he was hospitalized on the date of his absence from the Court.

In response to the order dated 01.05.2017, an affidavit has been filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga on behalf of State of Punjab that Dr. Ajay Bansal in his statement has stated that the alleged certificate was neither issued by him, nor the same bore his signature. Petitioner was never admitted in hospital as claimed by him in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also submitted

that the petitioner has been declared to be proclaimed offender today itself.

In view of above, no indulgence can be granted in favour of the petitioner. This petition is hereby dismissed.
