Vide this common order, CRM-M No.14882 of 2017
titled Lajjo @ Najo Vs. State of Punjab and another and CRM-M
No.15986 of 2017 titled Babli and another Vs. State of Punjab
and another are being disposed of.

On 01.05.2017, following order was passed in CRM-M
No.14882 of 2017:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends
that by way of rapat dated 29.08.2014, it was found by*

the police that the complainant was in the habit of visiting the house of a widow frequently which was situated adjoining to the houses of the accused. The background in which the alleged utterances in respect of calling the complainant as leader and getting himself photographed with leaders have necessary connectivity with a fact that no male member was arrayed as an accused in the complaint itself.

Notice of motion for 19.05.2017.”

With reference to rapat dated 29.08.2014, the conduct of the complainant would be ascertained on the basis of evidence. The police has *prima facie* recorded that the complainant himself is in the habit of visiting adjoining house of a widow. The background in which alleged utterances were made would be debatable at the time of trial.

Petitioners are directed to appear before the trial Court within ten days from today and in the event of their appearance, they shall be granted bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court. However, they shall keep on appearing before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing.

Both the petitions stand disposed of.
