The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 not to call and harass the petitioner on the false and frivolous applications of respondent No.5 on the same set of allegations, for which the petitioner is already facing trial in case bearing FIR No.102, dated 25.06.2013, under Section 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Dirbha, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner only prays for the relief that the representation dated 22.03.2017 (Annexure P-4), moved to the SSP, Sangrur, by the petitioner-Vijay Kumar, be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, respondent No.2-SSP, Sangrur is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-4) and pass appropriate order within two months, as per law, after receiving the certified copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
