LISA GILL, J.

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and for registration of a criminal case against respondents No. 6 to 8.

In the short reply filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4, it is stated that the allegations raised by the petitioner in her various complaints were found to be false. In fact on a complaint dated 05.02.2015 by Parwinder Kaur wife of Rajinder Singh @ Lucky-respondent No. 8, FIR No. 38 dated 10.02.2015, under Sections 148,149,323 and 506 IPC was registered at Police Station Chandimandir. The challan/report has been filed and 12 witnesses out of 14 already stand examined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even during the pendency of this petition, the petitioner was yet again attacked on 24.06.2015. In this respect, learned counsel for the State on instructions from Head Constable Pawan Kumar, Police Station Chandi Mandir, Panchkula submits that FIR No. 170 dated 27.06.2015 has been registered under Sections 147,148,323 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' for

short). The challan/report under Section 173 Cr. P.C. has been presented and the matter is now fixed for prosecution evidence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had sought time on 25.10.2016 for placing on record certain documents. The matter was adjourned yet again on the next date on his request. However, no documents are forthcoming till date.

In view of the facts and circumstances as above, no further directions are called for in this case. However, the petitioner is at liberty to seek her remedies as may be available to her in accordance with law in respect to the allegations raised by her in the various representations appended with this petition. It is further directed that in case the petitioner approaches respondents No. 3 to 5 in respect of any threat to her life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 6 to 8, respondent No. 3 shall look into the matter and take necessary steps as may be required.
