The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.100 dated 08.11.2016 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 506 IPC at Police Station Division No.8, District Ludhiana, in view of compromise.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ramandeep Sandhu, Sr. D.A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Mr. Sita Ram complainant, who is present in this Court has also accepted notice.

Heard forthwith with consent of learned counsel for the parties and the complainant in person.

The complainant submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties in the mediation centre of this Court.

This Court had made order dated 19.12.2016 in the petition

CRM-M-41911-2016, pending between the same parties, asking the

parties to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for settling the matter amicably.

Accordingly the mediation Centre has sent its report along with settlement Mark X in **CRM-M-41911-2016**. As per the settlement the complainant has received a demand draft of ₹35,000/- and is satisfied with the settlement.

In view of the above, looking to the settlement and the nature of the offence I think the compromise/compounding should be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-14887 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The FIR No.100 dated 08.11.2016 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 506 IPC at Police Station Division No.8, District Ludhiana, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings, qua the petitioner.
