Mr.Kamal Narula, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and filed vakalatnama on his behalf, which is taken on record.

It is stated by counsel for the petitioners that as directed by this Court vide order dated 1.5.2017, the petitioners have since appeared in the trial Court within three days and they have been granted interim bail.

The FIR registered regarding the incident is said to have resulted in forwarding a cancellation report by the police after completion of investigation, though on a protest petition having been filed by the complainant, it has been treated as a complaint, which is pending. The main purpose was to procure the presence of petitioners

which has been so done.

Under the circumstances, the interim bail granted to the petitioners on 1.5.2017 is made absolute, subject to their fulfilling conditions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
