Petitioner-Rambir has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.189 dated 02.07.2010, registered at Police Station Faridabad Kotwali, District Faridabad, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 381, 120-B IPC and Sections 71 and 73 of the Information Technology Act, 2000.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Vide order dated 23.05.2017, the petitioner was released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court till date.

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From the record, I find that the present petitioner is named on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused namely Kiran Pal, who is the main accused. No specific allegation has been levelled against the present petitioner. The only allegation of connivance is there against him.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in this petition, the same is allowed. Interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.05.2017 is made absolute.
