JITENDRA CHAUHAN.J.(ORAL)

This order shall dispose of afore-mentioned two anticipatory bail applications arising out of the common FIR No.82 dated 16.03.2016, registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Zirakpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the entire loan amount stands repaid to the bank. The bank is to issue 'No Due Certificate'. On receipt of 'No Due Certificate' which is expected to be received by the petitioners within 10 days, the petitioners shall within three weeks thereafter execute sale-deed in favour of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the complainant has accepted the proposal. However, the complainant has all reservation with regard to commitment made by the petitioners keeping in view their past conduct.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that in pursuance of the orders dated 09.05.2016, 12.05.2016 and the subsequent orders passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the orders dated 09.05.2016 and 12.05.2016 passed by this Court are made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioners to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petitions are allowed.

However, it is made clear that in case the undertaking made before this Court is not complied with within the stipulated period, this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed without further notice and the aggrieved party shall have liberty to revive the present petition.
