This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.385 dated 13.07.2016, under Sections 365, 363, 366-A, 376, 120-B, 506 IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station, Gohana City, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per statement dated 07.02.2017 (Annexure P-2), the prosecutrix has turned hostile. This fact is not being disputed by the learned State counsel.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this

petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular

bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial
