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Petitioner-Anaro has filed this petition under Section 439 of
the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case
FIR No.44 dated 22.02.2016, registered at Police Station Badhra,
District Bhiwani, under Sections 323, 325, 302, 506 and 34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

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Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner is a lady. Although, she is stated to be armed with *danda*, but no specific injury has been attributed to her. There is only general allegation that she caused injuries to the deceased.

The petitioner has been in custody since 03.03.2016. She is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as she is in judicial custody. Now, she is only to face the trial which will take a long time. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by keeping her in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
