Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had been admitted to bail by the learned trial Court and he was also appearing as and when summoned by that Court. However, on 12.4.2017 he could not come present as he had 'noted the wrong date'.

In view of the petitioners' admitted absence, I see no ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail. Hence, this petition is dismissed.

However, upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and presenting an application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for 'regular bail', it would be disposed of on its own merits, as expeditiously as possible, and if the petitioner was found absent only on one date, for which he can give an explanation to satisfy that Court, the bail application would be disposed of within one day. However, if he is found to have remained absent

on more than one occasion, then the direction for decision within one day shall not operate.
