Counsel for the petitioner would submit that dispute between the parties has been settled by way of compromise dated 06.03.2017 and in pursuance thereof, the petitioner has already paid an amount of Rs.5,00,000/- to the complainant and a demand draft of Rs.15,00,000/- has been prepared today and handed over to counsel for the complainant.

Counsel for the complainant concedes to this position that dispute between the parties has been settled in view of terms and conditions incorporated in the compromise deed dated 06.03.2017, a copy whereof has been supplied to the Court and taken on record. He has further conceded that an amount of Rs.5,00,000/- has already been paid to the complainant and a demand draft of Rs.15,00,000/- has been received by him on behalf of complainant today in the Court. He further stated that in view of compromise, complainant has got no objection if interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute.

In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of.
Interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.05.2016 is

made absolute subject to the conditions incorporated in the order of interim bail. However, the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of compromise arrived at between them.
