ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of DDR No.26 dated 14.11.2015, under Sections 324, 34 IPC in case FIR No.223 dated 14.11.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 452, 148 & 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, on the basis of compromise dated 28.02.2016 (Annexure P/2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the afore-noted DDR pertains to an incident wherein sudden quarrel took place between the parties and only simple injuries were caused therein. He further states that the FIR on the basis of compromise has already been quashed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-8963-2016.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 01.05.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of CJM, Ferozepur, dated 22.05.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is an offshoot of a sudden quarrel between the parties and the matter has now been compromised. Even the FIR has already been quashed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-8963-2016.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and DDR No.26 dated 14.11.2015, under Sections 324, 34 IPC in case FIR No.223 dated 14.11.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 452, 148 & 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
