Despite Service, no one has appeared on behalf of respondent No. 8. As a matter of consequence, respondent No. 8 is proceeded against ex-parte.

The grievance of the petitioners is that on the frivolous complaints filed by respondent No. 8, on account of matrimonial dispute, they are being summoned at different Police Stations and are being harassed.

In the circumstances, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the State that in case the presence of the petitioners are required at the Police Station then they will not be summoned except by way of issuing summons in writing under Section 160 Cr. P.C.
