The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.135 dated 06.09.2014 registered under Section 22/61/85 Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier the petitioner was on bail. The petitioner was again arrested on 27.01.2017 and is in jail since then. He further submits that three witnesses have been examined out of total six witnesses and the remaining witnesses will be examined shortly. He further submits that there is no other case against the petitioner.

Looking to the period of detention and the fact that there is no other case pending against the petitioner and the trial will take its own

time, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-15122 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not tamper or influence the prosecution witness(es).
- (iv) In case of violation of the above condition the liberty is reserved to apply for cancellation of bail.
