The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a complaint case No.17/2009 dated 03.12.2009, under Section 7 of Essential Commodities Act, 1955 pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rewari.

It stands uncontroverted that the petitioner having evaded the process of law, has been declared as proclaimed offender by the trial Court vide order dated 01.09.2015. Even a revision petition preferred by the petitioner has been dismissed by the Sessions Court, Rewari in the light of order dated 04.08.2016.

This Court vide order carrying even date has even dismissed the petition filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. assailing the order of proclaimed offender dated 01.09.2015.

Under such circumstances, conduct of the petitioner dis-entitles him to the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition dismissed.
