Petitioners had been granted concession of pre-arrest bail by this Court on 01.02.2016 in a case of assault. On addition of offence under Section 307 IPC, the petitioners have approached this Court for grant of pre-arrest bail in the added offence also.

Mr. Sumit Puri, Advocate for the complainant has intervened to oppose application for pre-arrest bail contending that the petitioners are guilty of having injured three persons but at the same time, he is not able to satisfy as to which of the petitioner is attributed grievous injury or the injury which has endangered the life. As the petitioners had been granted concession of pre-arrest bail and they have not been attributed any grievous injury, the concession of pre-arrest bail can be extended in the case of added offence also.

On the instructions of ASI Gurmail Singh, it has been informed by the State counsel that the petitioners have joined the

investigation pursuant to the interim order passed by this Court in the added offence.

In view of said circumstances, the petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioners, they will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, as per the order already granted in their favour on 01.02.2016, subject to the conditions that the petitioners will not indulge in similar activity of which they are accused of during pendency of the trial; they will not in any manner threaten the witnesses and will not in any manner tamper with the evidence.

Nothing said in this order will affect the merits of the case.
