The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.174 dated 07.06.2016 registered under Sections 302, 506, 148, 149, 120-B and 401 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 411, 120-B and 201 were added lateron) and Sections 25, and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Basti Jodhewal, District Ludhiana.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

I have perused the evidence-Annexure P-2 of complainant-Kulpreet Singh @ Rubal-PW1, sofaras the petitioner-Gagan Arora is concerned. The allegation against the petitioner is that he had supplied the revolver bearing No.T-3054 that was stolen from the police officer and was ultimately utilized in the offence in question. In that view of the matter,

prima facie he is entitled to grant of bail. Petition for bail is allowed. The petitioner-Gagan Arora is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
