SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioner, who is the accused in FIR No.216 dated 15.12.2013 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC'), Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, has prayed for quashing of FIR and its proceedings pending in the Court of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kharar.

During the pendency of the trial, the complainant has arrived at a settlement with the accused vide compromise Annexure P-2, which is duly signed by him. He is represented by his counsel. In view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543* and *Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending since the complainant has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioner/accused and has furnished an affidavit to this

In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.216 dated 15.12.2013 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of IPC, Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
