On 03.05.2017, following order was passed:-

"The issue of sale of financed car without informing the finance company is involved in the present case. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner and one Satinder Pal Singh were friends. Satinder Pal Singh was not having requisite document to get the car financed. Petitioner came forward to help his friend. The car was financed in the name of the petitioner. As per the understanding between the petitioner and aforesaid Satinder Pal Singh, first ten installments in the sum of Rs.15,000/- per month were paid by the petitioner. The amount paid

by the petitioner was in consonance with the amount of the loan taken by him from his friend Satinder Pal Singh. Thereafter, Satinder Pal Singh did not pay the requisite installments, rather further sold the car to one Sukhwinder Singh. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner would make every endeavour to settle the issue with the finance company.

Notice of motion for 23.05.2017.

Till then, arrest of the petitioner is stayed.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the complainant was not privy to understanding between the petitioner and Satinder Pal Singh, yet the petitioner is interested in paying the entire amount in favour of the bank in one go.

Let the amount be paid to the Bank within 40 days from today. Demand draft be prepared in the name of the Bank and the same be handed over to the Investigating Officer within stipulated period. On doing so, the Investigating Officer shall admit the petitioner on bail subject to his satisfaction. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
