Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.43 dated 13.04.2017, under Sections 420, 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail. This Court had made an order dated 05.05.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Pursuant to the last order dated 05.05.2017, parties are identified by their respective counsel. Complainant-Sukhwinder Kaur stated before me with the assistance of her learned counsel that she has received the amount of ₹1.5 lakhs and also a cheque of ₹20,000/-. She further makes a statement that she has no grievance now since she has received the amount. In this regard, compromise has been filed by the learned counsel for the complainant today in Court and the same is

taken on record and marked as 'X' for identification. In that view of the matter, I do not think it necessary to decline the relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated 05.05.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
