In response to notice issued on 02.05.2017, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sushil Kumar, submits that the statements of the petitioners, as also respondent no.7 and other persons have been got recorded by the police of Police Station Lambra, District Jalandhar, to the effect that the matter has been compromised and as per the instructions of the learned State counsel, in fact a 'sending off' ceremony was also performed by the family of petitioner no.1.

As regards the age of petitioner no.2, it is stated to have been confirmed to be of the same date as is given in the petition.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, though with a direction to respondents no.2 and 3 to

otherwise ensure that the lives and liberty of the petitioners continue to be protected, within the four corners of law.
