The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.44 dated 29.04.2015 for the offence under Sections 306/120B/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

Petitioner is in custody since 13.07.2015. Learned counsel for the State has informed the Court that out of 14 witnesses, 5 witnesses have been examined. It is stated that on 21.04.2015, Shinder Kaur wife of complainant and Manpreet Kaur daughter of the complainant went to attend the Court proceedings where, petitioner and his co-accused started intimidating them and gave threats that in case they failed to compromise, they would have to face loss of property and life. Due to those threats, Manpreet Kaur committed suicide on 28.04.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that deceased died a natural death which is clear from the inquest report under Section 174 Cr.P.C. which was duly signed by mother of the deceased namely Shinder Kaur.

Keeping in view the above and considering the fact that trial is not likely to mature in near future, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Moga.
