In FIR No.5 dated 02.01.2017 registered under Sections 419/420/467/468/471/120-B and 201 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Sections 66-C/66-D of I.T. Act, 2000 and Section 3/14 of Foreigner Act at Police Station Rajendra Park, Gurugram, District Gurugram, the petitioner is in custody since, 05.01.2017.

Upon having heard learned counsel for the rival parties and upon perusal of the FIR in question, looking to the role of the petitioner, it appears that the role of the co-accused is main as against the present petitioner.
