This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case arising out of FIR No.20 dated 05.04.2017 under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 and 120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Women Police Station, Panchkula.

Petitioners are the parents-in-law of the complainant. Husband of the complainant bail granted on even date with the condition that he shall deposit an amount of ₹15 lacs in F.D.R. in the name of the complainant with the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that the mediation has failed.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, interim bail was granted to the petitioners vide order dated 03.05.2017 passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioners shall join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Sections 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
