Main Case

By filing the present petition, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 27 dated 23.03.2017, registered under Sections 308, 341, 323 read with Section 34 of IPC, at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar.

It is contended that the injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature and are on non-vital parts. Nothing is to be recovered from him. He is ready to join the investigation.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

Heard.

As per FIR, the petitioner gave baseball bat blow on the right bicep of Gurpreet Singh, injured and on the middle of head of the complainant, namely Pargat Singh. As many as six injuries were noticed on the person of Gurpreet Singh, injured and six injuries on the person of Pargat Singh, complainant. Keeping in view the nature of injuries and role of the petitioner, this Court feels that it is a fit case where custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required to unearth the truth. No case for pre-arrest bail is made out at this stage.

Dismissed.
